All articles published in TOG are subject to peer review. On initial submission, the Editor-in-Chief and at least one Editor review articles to decide whether or not they are suitable. At this stage, revisions may be requested prior to further peer review. Most manuscripts are then reviewed by two peer reviewers who are not Editorial Board members. Articles in the 'Ethics' section are reviewed by the Editors and one external reviewer unless additional expert opinion is required by the Editors. Articles in the 'New developments' and 'Views and counter views' sections are reviewed only by the Editors unless they require further expert opinion. Where there is disagreement, the Editor-in-Chief's decision is final.
